## Citizen of the Year Brianna O'Hagan

Brianna O'Hagan, the general manager of EGP Oceanside, is not just dedicated to running a successful gastropub. She's also a passionate advocate of community service and was recently awarded Chamber of Commerce's 2024 Citizen of the Year.

Brianna has deep roots in the area- she was born and raised in East Rockaway— and her community involvement began organically, driven by a desire to make local connection. As a teenager, Brianna was always involved in local events such as the Oktoberfest, the Stars and Stripes Festival, a community 5K Run, and programs for kids. It was only natural for her to segue into a career that allowed her to expand and cultivate her volunteer efforts.

It has been said, "Life as a teacher begins the day you realize that you are always a learner." Having attended Molloy University with a goal of becoming an educator, Brianna thought this was a clear career path. After earning her teaching degree— but having misgiving about the state's Common Core curriculum — she took her father's advice and tried the restaurant business, which she came to think of as another form of teaching. While the day-to-day activities may differ, both running a restaurant and being a teacher require a combination of interpersonal, organizational, and leadership skills. Both professions also involve serving others—whether it's providing a satisfying dining experience or facilitating the learning and growth of students. Successful restaurant management involves leading a team, providing direction, and fostering a positive work environment. Teamwork is essential for delivering high-quality service. With her passion and dedication, Brianna continues to hone her craft and build her team up in the process.

The oldest of four siblings, Brianna has long had a passion for giving back, which she credits to her dad. Her father, Tim O'Hagan, owner of EGP, was a basketball coach at Molloy College, now Molloy University. At Molloy, he teamed up with the Friends of Jaclyn Foundation, a nonprofit devoted to improving the lives of children with brain tumors and their families, which matched children in need of love, support and friendship with college and high school sports teams. As the eldest child, Brianna wanted to serve as an inspiration to her siblings.

Volunteerism refers to the practice of individuals willingly offering their time, skills, and efforts to support and contribute to a cause or organization without monetary compensation. The motivation behind volunteerism is often driven by a desire to make a positive impact, help others in need, or contribute to the betterment of society. Volunteers play a crucial role in addressing various societal issues and promoting a sense of community and civic responsibility. This past holiday season, Brianna held her 11th annual Holiday Toy Drive and Adopt a Family event, in which over 500 toys were donated. A decade ago, Brianna who still lives in East Rockaway, started organizing toy drives with sports teams when she was a softball coach at East Rockaway High School, after she graduated in 2010. To promote sportsmanship, she teamed up with the girls' varsity basketball team to collaborate with visiting teams before games to donate toys to NYU Langone Cancer Center for Kids. She brought the drive to South Side High School & Garden City High School as well and discovered that more and more people wanted to be involved with it.

The toy drive began modestly with Brianna collecting toys out of her house. Over the years, the effort has grown substantially, involving local sports teams, businesses, and organizations, as well as residents. Brianna and her crew of volunteers sort and distribute gifts to 25 local families during the holiday season. Adopt a Family volunteers work from local children's wish lists. The rest of the toys are donated to the Cancer Center for Kids and any local organizations or families in-need.

Volunteers are motivated by a selfless desire to contribute to the well-being of others or the community. The annual Fall Fest, which was first initiated by Brianna and her team at EGP Oceanside, stands out as a testament to her commitment to the Oceanside Family. The event was first created to give back and create a connection between the community and the local business. For the first year, knowing that there was a local teenager who was battling cancer, Brianna used the pumpkin patch as a fundraising platform. From there, Brianna and her team realized what this day could really do for people in-need within the Oceanside community.

Each year, the Fall Fest benefits a local family facing challenges and/or hardships. The Fest started as a way to bring people together, and gradually evolved into a platform for giving back. The special day has created endless bonds with the families that she has helped.

Despite her busy schedule, Brianna remains dedicated to her community. She said that while the honor of Citizen of the Year is appreciated, her primary focus remains on doing what she believes is the right thing for the community.

It is for her dedication to the Oceanside community through her continued volunteerism efforts that the Oceanside Chamber of Commerce has decided to honor Brianna as the 2024 Citizen of the Year.

# Ramalho Tree Service

Ramalho Tree Service is a three-generation, family owned and operated tree service located in Oceanside, New York.

Ramalho Tree was started in 1958 by John A. Ramalho, Jr. Fresh out of the Navy, John returned home and resumed working for a local tree business. After a few months he realized he was doing all the work and someone else was reaping the benefits so, he bravely decided to venture out on his own. Going door to door, introducing himself and offering his services, John was determined to make a name for himself. People he knew put in a good word for him, they gave him a place to park his truck, and somewhere to dump, split, and store his wood. When he outgrew that location, someone else offered to rent him a small lot where he would stay for many years. But, as with all rentals, the time came when he needed to move on. Word of mouth got around, a friend told him they knew of a place for sale, but being a young, married man with three children to support and a mortgage to pay he didn't think he could make ends meet. To his surprise, someone he looked up to believed that he could make a name for himself stepped up and offered to hold the mortgage on the property. And so, John Ramalho d/b/a John Ramalho Tree Surgery was up and running with a place to hang his hat.

John A. Ramalho, Jr. never forgot the people who helped him get his start. He was appreciative and paid it forward by hiring family members who had lost their jobs so, that they could be able to support their families. He also hired young men who needed work and someone to teach them a trade and he cut pricing for people who were just scraping by. Whether it was lending money to someone so they could land on their feet, loaning a truck to a friend, or just helping someone fix a saw or other piece of equipment, he always remembered he was where he was because of hard work, determination, and the help of some good people along the way.

As they say, the apple doesn't fall far from the tree and John's son John followed right in his father's footsteps. Going to work with his dad as a kid, hanging with the guys, getting rides in the pay loader, and dragging brush - the next generation of John Ramalho's was a part of the business from the day he

was born. He worked every day after school, weekends, holidays, and summer vacations until he graduated high school in 1979. He then became a full time employee of the business. Working side by side, the two John's worked for celebrities such as Howard Stern and prominent families including the Snapple and Pergament families. They cleared lots for local churches such as St. Christopher's in Baldwin, St. Anthony's here in Oceanside, and for Mercy Medical Center in Rockville Centre. They were called to clean up properties in Old Westbury after the crash of the Avianca flight where they recovered jewelry which they rightfully returned to the airlines so families could receive some type of closure. They removed trees for the development of golf courses, installations of pools and tennis courts, and the building of new homes. For years, they were the go to tree company for the Village of Freeport, Village of Old Westbury, Village of East Rockaway, and numerous golf clubs.

1994 brought about the start of the next generation of Ramalho men. John W. Ramalho came into this world with big shoes to fill. As a toddler he could be seen sitting in his car seat during wood deliveries earning tips for just being the cute kid in the truck. Seven and nine years later, the last two Ramalho boys would come into the picture and like their older brother, they too proudly wore the orange Ramalho sweatshirt that has become the family uniform. Giving up weekends, days at the beach, and missing out on time with their friends became a normal way of life when there was wood to split, wood to be delivered and stacked, and jobs to get done.

In 2018, at the age of 82, the original John Ramalho decided it was time to hang up his orange cap and let the next generation run the show. In 2019, John Ramalho d/b/a John Ramalho Tree Surgery officially became Ramalho Tree Service, Inc. run by John Ramalho, John W. Ramalho, and Sam Ramalho, with added support behind the scenes from Victoria & Jake Ramalho. This family business had a lot to live up to. Performing all aspects of tree care, such as removals, prunings, elevating, stump grinding, and planting, no job is too big or too small. John W. and Sam are constantly looking to learn more about new equipment, upcoming and coming ways to enhance performance, and ways to continually improve customer service. Yet, while success and prosperity are of course important, the greatest mission of all members of the Ramalho family is the desire to make the original John Ramalho proud. With the constant support and dedication of the business' office manager, Rachael, and their loyal, extremely hardworking employees, Ramalho tree service is going strong. They have not, however, forgotten where it is that this business came from. They continue to live by the motto of people helping people.

Devoting time and volunteering their services to numerous Oceanside

organizations, Ramalho Tree Service has become a staple in the community and a family that everyone knows they can count on. Whether it is hanging lights around town for the holidays, or donating cookies for decorating at numerous events, you can always rely on the Ramalho family and it's involvement. They participate in toy drives, have donated to numerous food drives, and have adopted local families for the holidays. They are always one of the first to step in and support families facing hardships, whether it is a financial burden, health issue, or loss of a loved one. Donations of wood chips havebeen made to both the School #8 mediation labyrinth and the recently overhauled arboretum at the School #6 complex. Additionally, large pieces of wood have been delivered to the high school to the materials processing classes for use in making benches and other items. Ramalho Tree further assisted the high school by helping to move the shed won by a local resident that had been constructed by the class and raffled off. John has helped at the Schoolhouse Green with the clean up and preparation for the 9-11 event. The family has assisted in keeping Louis Alvarez Park clean, neat, and safe. Ramalho Tree Service was a proud part of this year's first Oceanside Fall Festival where they not only sponsored the Axe throwing event, but they also assisted with the setup, presentation, and clean up. When asked to do something to help a family member, friend, community member, business, or charitable organization, the word "no" is not in the Ramalho family vocabulary.

Oceanside is proud to have this three-generation business in our community. For their outstanding service and devotion to Oceanside, one can see why the Oceanside Chamber of Commerce is happy to award Ramalho Tree Service, Inc. the Business of the Year Award.


